

## What is the salutation given in the Qur'an?

The Qur'an introduces itself as *the guidance for the worlds* (3:96); and *the manifest light* (4:174).

According to Quran, Allah has laid down solutions for every human problem in the Quran very clearly. Allah says in the Qur'an: "*and we have revealed the Book to you explaining clearly everything* (16:89). Also He has described the Qur'an in these words: "*a guidance for mankind and clear evidence of guidance and discrimination (between wrong)*". (2:185).

The Qur'an is the guidance, the evidence, the discrimination between right and wrong and the manifest light for all people to guide them aright. Allah says in the Qur'an: "*And (as for) those who strive hard for Us, We will most certainly guide them onto our ways*", (29:69) in addition, the Quran proclaims that the Quran is complete, perfect, and fully detailed (6:19, 38, 114, 115; and 50:45).

Michael following are a list of the places where Salaamun and Salaamaa are used, please verify with your Qur'an in the Arabiyya transliteration:

1. Surah 97, Ayat 5, "Peace (Salaamun **سَلَامٌ**) until the rising of the dawn.

2. Surah 56, Ayat 90-91, and if he is of those on the right hand, Then "Peace ( **فَسَلَامٌ**

**Salaamun**) be unto thee" from those on the right hand.

3. Surah 56, Ayat 25-26, "There hear they no vain talk or recrimination, but the saying: Peace, ( **سَلَامًا** Salaamaa) Peace ( **سَلَامٌ** Salaamun).

4. Surah 51, Ayat 25, "Hath the story of Abraham's honored guests reached thee? When they came in unto him and said: Peace ( **سَلَامًا** Salaamaa)! He answered, Peace

(**Salaamun** **سَلَامٌ**): Folk unknown".

5. Surah 40, Ayat 73, "And those who keep their duty to their Rabb (Lord) are driven unto the Garden in troops till, when they reach it, and the gates thereof are opened, and the warders thereof say unto them: Peace ( **سَلَامٌ** Salaamun) be unto you! Ye are good, so enter ye to dwell therein"

6. Surah 37, Ayat 37, “And peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto those sent (to warn). And praise is to Allah, Rabb (Lord) of the Worlds’.

7. Surah 37, Ayats 120, “Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto Moses and Aaron”, Ayat 130, “Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto Elias”, Ayat 109, “Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto Abraham”,

Surah 79, “Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto Noah among the peoples”.

8. Surah 28, Ayat 55, “And when they hear vanity they withdraw from it and say: Unto us our works and unto you your works. Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto you! We desire not the ignorant”.

9. Surah 27, Ayat 59, “Say: Praise is to Allah, and Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be on His slaves whom He hath chosen! Is Allah best, or what ye ascribe as partners”

10. Surah 19, Ayat, 46-47, He said: Rejectest thou my gods, O Abraham? If thou cease not, I shall surely stone thee. Depart from me a long while! He (Abraham) said: Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto thee! I shall ask forgiveness of my Rabb (Lord) for thee. Lo! He was ever gracious unto me”.

11. Surah 19, Ayat 15, “Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) on him the day he was born, and the day he dies and the day he shall be raised alive”.

12. Surah 16, Ayat 32, “Those whom the angels cause to die good. They say: Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto you! Enter the Garden because of what ye used to do”.

13. Surah 13, Ayat 24, “Peace (سَلَامٌ **Salaamun**) be unto you because ye persevered. Ah, passing sweet will be the sequel of the Home.

14. Surah 19, Ayat 62, “They hear therein no idle talk, but only Peace (سَلَامًا **Salaamaa**); and therein they have food for morn and evening. (62) Such is the Garden which we cause the devout among our bondmen to inherit.

15. Surah 21, Ayat 69, “We said: O fire, be coolness and peace (سَلَامًا **Salaamaa**) for Abraham”.

16. Surah 20, Ayat 47, “So go ye unto him and say: Lo! We are two messengers of thy Rabb (Lord). So let the children of Israel go with us, and torment them not. We bring thee a token from thy Rabb (Lord). And The Peace (السَّلَامُ **The Salaamun**) will be for him who followeth right guidance”.

Just to provide some clarity on the words Salaamun, Allah says in the Qur’an surah 14, Ayat 23, “And those who believed and did good works are made to enter Gardens underneath which rivers flow, therein abiding by permission of their Rabb (Lord), their greeting therein: Peace (سَلَامٌ

**Salaamun**). Surah 15, Ayats 46-52, “Enter them in peace (بِسَلَامٍ **Salaamun**)”.

Respectfully submitted to you, as I told you there is not one Ayat in the Qur’an that say’s As-Salaam-Alaykum, however if you should find one let me know. The greeting As-Salaam-Alaykum is found in those fabricated man-made lying hadiths condemned by Allah over and over in the Qur’an. Let’s talk my Brother.
